Dear Property Owner:

Leggette, Brashears & Graham, Inc. (LBG), Professional Groundwater & Environmental Engineering Services, has been retained by Thompson Education Center, LLCA to conduct a well monitoring program of neighboring wells located in proximity to their supply wells located on the Wild Turnpike property. We request your participation in this well monitoring program. Residential wells will be monitored for a period of one week, tentatively scheduled mid to late January 2017 (weather dependent) to determine the potential water-level effects from the pumping of the supply wells, if any.

Monitoring would consist of the collection of depth-to-water measurements from your well. LBG would carry identification and would only enter your property during daylight hours. Please note if your well head is inaccessible or buried beneath the ground, your well cannot be monitored.

The measurement procedure does not interfere with the normal use of your well water. A sufficient number of measurements would be taken so that effects due to operating cycles of your own pump could be distinguished from any drawdown caused by the pumping of the study wells, if any. At the conclusion of the test, LBG would provide you with a simple graph of the water-level measurements from your well, with a letter of explanation.

Such monitoring programs have been carried out successfully and without incident in yours and other nearby communities. LBG is adequately insured in the event of any unforeseen difficulty. Should you choose to participate in this well monitoring program, we request that the property owner endorse the permission form below on a duplicate of this letter.
