- 9. No payment for work will be made until job is completed and air quality reports, if required, are approved.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

A. Insurance Requirements

The successful bidder shall be required to provide for itself and maintain at its own cost and expense until the completion of the work the following forms of insurance:

- 1. Commercial General Liability coverage with limits of liability not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence and not less than Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) annual aggregate.
- 2. The Town of Thompson shall be named as an additional insured on the policies required by subparagraphs (A and B) above (4052 State Route 42, Monticello, N.Y. 12701).

The successful bidder shall furnish certificates of insurance to the Town of Thompson and corresponding policy endorsement setting forth the required coverage hereunder prior to commencing any work, and such policies shall contain an endorsement requiring the carrier to give at least ten days' prior notice of cancellation to the Town of Thompson. All insurance required shall be primary and non-contributing to any insurance maintained by the Town of Thompson. The successful bidder shall ensure that any subcontractors hired carry insurance with the same limits and provisions provided herein. The successful bidder agrees to cause each subcontractor to furnish the Town of Thompson with copies of certificates of insurance and the corresponding policy endorsements setting forth the required coverage hereunder prior to any such subcontractor commencing any work.

B. Indemnification

The successful contractor shall defend, indemnify and save harmless the Town of Thompson, its employees and agents, from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of, or in consequence of, any negligent or intentional act or omission of the successful contractor, its employees or agents, to the extent of its or their responsibility for such claims, damages, losses and expenses.

C. Non-Collusive Certification

By submission of this RFQ, each contractor and each person signing on behalf of any contractor certifies, and in the case of a joint proposal each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of his knowledge and belief:

- The prices in this proposal have been arrived at independently without collusion, consultation, communication, or agreement, for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other contractor or with any competitor; and

- No attempt has been made or will be made by the contractor to induce any other person, partnership or corporation to submit or not to submit a proposal for the purpose of restricting competition.

D. MWBE Promotion

It is the policy of the Town of Thompson that Minority-Owned Business Enterprises (MBE) and Women-Owned Business Enterprises (WBE) are afforded the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of contracts. It is also the Town of Thompson's goal to award Procurement Contracts to those procurement contractors who have evidenced compliance with the laws of the State of New York prohibiting discrimination in employment.

E. Non-Discrimination Policy

In accordance with Article 15 of N.Y. Executive Law (also known as the Human Rights Law) and all other State and Federal statutory and constitutional non-discrimination provisions, the Contractor agrees that neither it nor any of its subcontractors shall, by reason of age, race, creed, color, national origin, sexual orientation, military status, sex, disability, predisposing genetic characteristics or marital status refuse to hire or employ or to bar or to discharge from employment such individual or to discriminate against such individual in compensation or in terms, conditions or privileges of employment.

 of the firm's capabilities to satisfy the requirements of this Bid. Emphasis should be on
 completeness and clarity of content.
- The contents of the bid proposal submitted by the successful firm and this Bid may become part of
 the contract for these services. The successful firm will be expected to execute said contract with
 the Town of Thompson as well as the Town of Thompson Contract Rider which is attached to this
 Request for Quotes document in Attachment C.

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) is proposing a Department Initiated Modification (DIM) to the State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) Permit NY0035645, pursuant to 6 NYCRR Part 750-1.18, and 750-1.19, the Priority Ranking System known as New York State's Environmental Benefit Permit Strategy (EBPS).

The facility receives sanitary wastewater from domestic users and provides treatment for a design flow of 0.41 MGD. The facility discharges treated wastewater via Outfall 001 to McKee Brook, a class B(T) water. Current treatment consists of: screening, equalization, activated sludge-sequential batch reactor, filter feed equalization, sand filtration, chlorination, and post aeration. Sludge is stored and hauled for processing at Kiamesha Lake WWTP.

The following changes to the permit are proposed: A new daily maximum effluent limit for Total Residual Chlorine (TRC) has been added; A Mercury Minimization program has been added; A temperature management plant has been added; and, a schedule of compliance has been added to meet the TRC limit.

As a result of the EBPS full technical review, a new five-year term is proposed. The permit includes updated forms and the latest general conditions.
