We have owned our home at 9 Beach Rd. on Wanaksink for 3 years. One of the reason that we return is the natural beauty of the site and the lake overall. Because the club is so restrictive about cutting of trees, the wooded perimeter appears undisturbed. Our children are so attached to the lake that they vacation with us every year.

If the weather is good we either sit on our porch or go down to the dock to see the sunset every evening. We are on and around the lake all the time during the summer, and would not want the cell tower literally towering over us all day.

Although there are no photographs of the impact on Wanaksink in the Verizon application, I'm happy that you asked that balloon photos be taken so that you will be aware of how seriously the current proposed tower site will affect our community, and that you will consider other sites to provide better cell service to the Rock Hill community.

When the new photographs are available, we urge you to hold another public hearing to allow discussion of the balloon test results.
