My family has owned our house at 91 South Shore Road at Wanaksink Lake since 1942, when my grandparents visited friends at Wanaksink Lake. They loved it so much that they bought our house two weeks later virtually sight unseen. They owned a grocery business in Marlboro, New York working 6 days a week and would drive up to Wanaksink on Saturday evenings after they closed their store, looking forward to the respite from their hard working week. For my entire life I have spent my summers at Wanaksink and our son will make the 4th generation of our family who loves our treasured spot.

The view from our deck and our dock has not changed much at all over these years and it is a special ritual to enjoy the beautiful sunsets with friends and family. We have taken probably thousands of photos, each one of them with different nuances of light and color and I can't imagine the visual assault of a cell tower sticking up over the trees into the sky.
