Dear Town Supervisor Rieber and Enforcement Officer Morey:

I write to you today in my personal capacity as a resident taxpayer at 20 Sunset Drive, Monticello NY 12701 (SBL: 48.-1-45) and a neighbor immediately adjacent Town of Thompson SBL: 48.-1-22.31 ("Subject Property").

I write to you today to make **DEMAND** pursuant to Town Law §268(2), which provides as follows:

In case any building or structure is erected, constructed, reconstructed, altered, converted or maintained, or any building, structure or land is used, or any land is divided into lots, blocks, or sites in violation of this article or of any local law, ordinance or other regulation made under authority conferred thereby, the proper local authorities of the town, in addition to

other remedies, may institute any appropriate action or proceedings to prevent such unlawful erection, construction, reconstruction, alteration, conversion, maintenance, use or division of land, to restrain, correct or abate such violation, to prevent the occupancy of said building, structure, or land or to prevent any illegal act, conduct, business or use in or about such premises; and upon the failure or refusal of the proper local officer, board or body of the town to institute any such appropriate action or proceeding for a period of ten days after written request by a resident taxpayer of the town so to proceed, any three taxpayers of the town residing in the district wherein such violation exists, who are jointly or severally aggrieved by such violation, may institute such appropriate action or proceeding in like manner as such local officer, board or body of the town is authorized to do.

(Emphasis added).

BACKGROUND

The Subject Property is a vacant, wooded parcel in the Town of Thompson located in the SR district consisting of approximately 35 acres situated south of Sackett Lake Road and west of SR 42. The Subject Property is bisected by Hemlock Lane, with the segment north of Hemlock Lane consisting of approximately 30 acres ("Northern Segment") and the segment south of Hemlock Lane and bordered on the south by Sunset Drive consisting of approximately 5 acres ("Southern Segment").

Pursuant to a deed dated July 27, 2020 and filed with the Sullivan County Clerk on August 11, 2020 as instrument no. 2020-5551, the Subject Property was conveyed by Chester W. Osborn to Wheat and Sons Property Management, Inc., a New York State business corporation ("Owner"). By permit dated January 4, 2021, a Building Permit was issued to Owner for "selective harvesting" of forest products ("Permit 20-0378"), and logging upon the Northern Segment commenced in earnest thereafter. On or about April 1, 2021, Owner dug or caused to be dug a trench several hundred feet long, a few feet wide, and perhaps two or more feet deep upon the Southern Segment from Hemlock Lane south toward the center of the Southern Segment.

ARGUMENT

"Selective Harvesting" of forest products is not permitted in the SR district in which the Subject Property is located.

"Harvesting of forest products and wild crops" is permitted in the RR-1, RR-2, HC-1, HC-2, and EBG East Broadway Gateway Districts in the Town of Thompson. Such activities are not permitted in the SR, CI, and E Districts.

Pursuant to Town of Thompson §250-41(C):

"The officers and employees of the Building Department shall not issue a permit for the construction of any building or use of any property unless such building, property or use conforms to all other local laws and ordinances of the Town."

Pursuant to Town of Thompson §250-42 (F):

"Any building permit issued in violation of the provisions of this Part 1 shall be null and void and of no effect, without the necessity for any proceedings for revocation or nullification thereof, and any work undertaken or use established pursuant to such permit shall be unlawful."

As the use for which Permit No. 20-0378 was issued is not permitted in the SR zone, the aforesaid permit is "null and void and of no effect."

Owner has commenced site preparation upon the Southern Segment in violation of Town Code §255-6.

Owner has been open about his intention to construct several houses on the Southern Segment which would, of course, require subdivision of the Subject Property. It is equally clear that the trench described above is not intended for any purpose reasonably related to logging and/or Permit 20-0378, but constitutes site preparation (i.e., an effort to drain what appears to be ACOE wetlands situated on the Southern Segment). Site preparation, such as that described above, is not permitted by Town of Thompson Code §255-6 "prior to application, in writing, for approval of such proposed subdivision" in accordance with the procedures set forth in §255-7, et seq.

The Town's response to the undersigned's FOIL dated April 6, 2021 reveals that no application for subdivision of the Subject Property was submitted prior to the digging of

the aforesaid trench nor, upon information and belief, has any such application been received by the Town as of the date hereof.

Owner's actions upon the Southern Segment were conducted in violation of SEQRA.

Owner's stated desire to construct several houses upon the Southern Segment would constitute an unlisted action under SEQRA, as it does not fit within the description of any of the Type I or Type II actions set forth in 6 NYCRR 617.4, et seq. It is well-established that "[a] project sponsor may not commence any physical alteration related to an action until the provisions of SEQR have been complied with." 6 NYCRR 617.3. The only disturbances permitted in advance of the completion of the SEQR process "would be for minor disturbances necessary for information gathering about a project; e.g., property surveys, soil sampling, test wells, or temporary installation of various types of environmental monitoring equipment." The SEQR Handbook, 4th Ed., p. 14. Owner's attempt to drain what the undersigned believes to be ACOE wetlands clearly does not fall within this exception.

CONCLUSION

Given the above, I hereby make <u>**DEMAND**</u> pursuant to Town Law §268(2) for the Town Board of the Town of Thompson and/or the Building Department for the Town of Thompson to institute any appropriate action or proceedings to prevent the continued unlawful use of land detailed above, to restrain, correct or abate such violations, and to prevent any illegal act, conduct, business or use in or about the Subject Property.

COVID-19 ADDENDUM TO TOWN OF THOMPSON TOWN PARK FACILITY RENTAL AGREEMENT
