Any Bidder requiring documents to be shipped shall make arrangements with REVplans and pay for all packaging and shipping costs.

Any Addenda will be emailed from bidding service.

Each bid must be accompanied by security in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid in the form. The successful bidder, to whom the contract is awarded, will be required to provide a payment and performance bond equal to the full amount of the Contract.

New York State and Federal Prevailing Wage Requirements shall apply to this project.

Bids will be received on a lump sum basis.

Bids should exclude sales and compensating use taxes on materials incorporated in the work.

The Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, creed, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

No Bidder may withdraw his bid within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or irregularities in the Bids received, and to reject any or all Bids without explanation.
