PUBLIC NOTICE PLANNING BOARD WORKSHOP

The Town of Thompson Planning Board will hold a workshop on **Wednesday, November 12, 2025** at **6:30PM**, at the Thompson Town Hall located 4052 State Route 42 in Monticello, New York, to review and discuss a Draft Scoping document for the Heiden Road Riverside Warehouse project (the Proposed Action).

Description of the Proposed Action: The applicant (Kroeger USA, LLC) is proposing to construct a 1,500,400 square foot warehouse/ trucking terminal (as defined by the Thompson Zoning Code) with associated parking, loading and utility areas on 391.61 total acres located in the Commercial Industrial (CI) zoning district. The site is proposed to be served by private well and septic systems with all vehicular access via Heiden Road.

In accordance with the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), a positive declaration was issued by the Town of Thompson Planning Board (as Lead Agency) on October 8, 2025 and a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) on the Proposed Action will be prepared by the Applicant. The final Scoping Document adopted by the Planning Board will serve as the outline for what topics will be studied in the DEIS.
